GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS

- 1. Student must be a graduating senior attending a high school in the CBOR designated areas. This includes Caldwell, Canyon Springs, Gem State Academy, Greenleaf Friends Academy, Homedale, Marsing, Middleton, Notus, Parma, Thomas Jefferson Charter, Vallivue/Ridgevue, Vision Charter and Wilder, Elevate Academy, Homedale & Wilder Casa, Centennial Baptist.
- 2. To qualify applicant must be (A.) US Citizen, (B.) Graduating high school senior who has applied for admission to a post-secondary program, (C.) Who lives in the CBOR designated area.
- 3. Applicant must **email** a **1-minute video** explaining the issues of Home Ownership and Affordability in America?
- 4. Submit **one** letter of recommendation. This may be from a teacher, principal, counselor, or other administrator who should describe the student's activities and leadership record in high school. The letter of recommendation should also contain a description of character, initiative, and personal traits.
- 5. All applications for scholarship consideration must be returned to The CBOR Scholarship Committee Member via email or mailed to the above info no later than **February 29.** Mailed applications must have a **post-mark of no later than February 29, 2024.** Any application received after that date will **NOT** be considered.
- 6. Scholarship will be awarded upon receiving first semester college transcripts, proof of enrollment for second semester for Secondary Education. Transcripts must be received by January 1, 2025.
- 7. The Scholarship committee will arrange direct disbursement to the winner, to pick up scholarship check while home on break, to hand deliver back to school to pay for fees for second semester.
- 8. Awards presentation will be held at the CBOR Luncheon, **May 16, 2024,** at the Elks Lodge in Caldwell. Students will be notified of winning recipients no later than **April 15, 2024.** CBOR requests the winning recipients attend the Award Luncheon. Further details will be provided to winning recipients.
